

# Class Act

An engagement and intervention programme for potential NEET students

## **Module 1: Induction**

Duration: 1 day

Numbers: Max of 15 per programme

Students receive a one day induction to Class Act which sets the scene for the intensive programme. Working in syndicates the group will discuss rules and regulations of the programme, appropriate behaviour, aims and objectives, contents, visits, workbooks, individual learning programmes and outcomes.

## **Module 2: Teamwork Skills**

Duration: 2 days

Numbers: Max of 15 per programme

Students will visit an outdoor education centre to take part in a number of team building activities such as raft building, high and low ropes, archery, canoeing etc. This session supports the group in developing a bond and the staff to monitor needs.

## Module 3: Employability Skills

Duration: 4 days

Numbers: Max of 15 per programme

Working alongside business buddies, students will develop key employability skills through a range of WRL activities including mock interviews (based in a real workplace) and conflict resolution. The module also includes workplace visits and tours. This module leads onto preparation for work experience.



## **Module 4: Raising Aspirations**

Duration: 5 days

Numbers: Max of 15 per programme

Raising aspirations works collaboratively with a number of partners such as Aim Higher and Connexions. The module delivers a step into day, a working lunch and a drama workshop which all focus on future aspirations. Throughout this unit individuals will construct a CV and if in year 11 complete application forms for College. The unit also looks at an ongoing 'Next Steps Plan' and progression routes.

## **Module 5: Activities Award**

Duration: 4 days

Numbers: Max of 15 per programme

This unit allows staff to build a closer relationship with students through engaging activities such as skippering a boat, rocket ball and paintball. The activities award provides the motivational element of the programme and asks students to tackle situations that will take them out of their comfort zone. This module can be accredited through ASDAN short awards.

## Module 6: Business and Enterprise

Duration: 3 days

Numbers: 50 students

Students would take part in three enterprise events themed around the Olympics, Crime Scene Investigations and Dragons Den. Each event would focus on enterprise attributes, creativity and teamwork. Each event has a number of workshops in which groups rotate to gain numerous experiences.



## **Module 7: Army Boot Camp**

Duration: 5 days (including one overnight residential)

Numbers: Max of 15 per programme

Boot camp is an intense team building and self development programme. The group work as two competing syndicates throughout the week taking part in problem solving, logic, physical training and leadership tasks.

## **Module 8: Celebrating Success**

Duration: 1 day

Numbers: Max of 15 per programme

Each group will finish the engagement programme with a celebration event; this will mark their journey over the course of the year. Awards and certificates will be presented and invited guests (school representatives, parents and providers) will attend to listen to presentations about individuals and from individuals. The students plan and deliver this event as part of the programme.

## **Class Act PLUS – ALL MODULES**

The Class Act **PLUS** programme takes those students who are **most** at risk on a 25 day journey of re-engagement. Students go through the full entitlement, graduating with a confirmed progression route in place for September.

Class Act **Silver** involves students who require a middle means of intervention. These students would take the following modules:

1: Induction	£500
2: Teamwork Skills	£900
3: Employability Skills	£2300
4: Activities Award	£6300

**Total Cost** **£10,000**

## **Class Act LIGHT – THREE MODULES**

For those who require a little intervention to inspire a positive future. These students would take the following modules:

1: Induction	£500
2: Raising Aspirations	£3500
3: Activities Award	£6300

**Total cost** **£10,300**

+ Two FP at risk champions will support each group of 15
