Work Experience

The Scheme

TAG Aviation believes that work experience is crucial to a young person's development. It allows students to understand the ethos and culture of workplace values alongside the development of key communication and personal development skills. Working with First Partnership, the local Education Business organisation company, TAG have developed an accredited work experience scheme for year ten students.



Work experience with TAG is a great starting point for anyone with a genuine interest in business aviation. The scheme is structured so that young people see and experience all elements of business aviation from customer services to engineering, finance to marketing.

This allows students to gain an understanding of the diversity of jobs in business aviation as well as gathering information on progression pathways to aviation careers.

Accreditation

The Certificate:

On completion of a successful placement the student will be awarded with an OCR Certificate in Preparation for Employment at level 1 or 2.

To gain the certificate students must complete a workbook which focuses on the following:

- Rights and responsibilities in the workplace
- The work environment
- Following instructions in the workplace
- Working with others

Students will be mentored by TAG staff throughout and support will be given towards completion of the candidate evidence booklet.

The certificate will be forwarded to the candidate approximately six to eight weeks after completion.

TAG are keen to work with students who have a genuine interest in aviation.
